Dan Arnold is Assistant Professor of Philosophy of Religion in the Divinity School at the University of Chicago. His first book, *Buddhists, Brahmins, and Belief: Epistemology in South Asian Philosophy of Religion* (Columbia University Press, 2005), won an American Academy of Religion Award for Excellence in the Study of Religion.
